1. In a rural Tanzanian community, youth often find themselves link between traditional values and modern influences. Critically explain **six (06)** roles of normative philosophy in shaping youth behavior in Tanzania.
2. “Good conflict management enables parties to co-exist and handle their disputes by dealing with the underlying causes.” In light of this quotation, analyze **six (06)** styles and skills that may be used to manage conflicts in Africa.
3. The role of promoting science and technology in many countries rests under various entities, ranging from individuals, communities and the governments. In **six (06)** points evaluate how the government of Tanzania play its role.
4. In Tanzania, discussions around democracy often center on the importance of protecting human rights. However, various factors contribute to the ongoing challenges of human rights abuses in the country.
