3. (a) a candidate should read the passage and respond to the question as follows;

- The election took place last Friday
- Jumbe, George and Bakari were competing to become head boy
- Two days before polling, the contestants intensified their campaign in order to win the majority of the votes.
- Four teachers supervised the election process. (01@=05marks)
- Their supporter carried them shoulder high as they jumped and danced around the school, chanting the names of the winners announced.

(b) a candidate should construct a meaningful sentence according to the tense formula.

- I have done my work
- I am doing my work now
- He works in the garage every day (01@=05marks)
- He had danced the music
- I have been doing my work

4. A candidate should give out five stress placement rules with example

- Two-syllable nouns/adjectives; stress is usually on the first syllable (eg TA-ble, HAP-py)
- Two-syllable verbs/prepositions; stress is typically on the second syllable (eg re-CORD, be-LIEVE)
- Words ending in “-ic” “-sion”, “-tion”; stress falls on the second-last syllable (eg dra-MATIC, ex-plo-SION) (02@=10marks)
- Compound nouns; stress is on the first word (eg BLACK-board, HEAD-master)
- Compound adjectives/verbs; stress falls on the second word (eg out-RUN)

5. (A) **A candidate should write the long form of dictionary abbreviation.**
